**CECILVILLE SLAB**

Also known as Cecil Slab, this cliff is home to a bunch of moderate sport climbs and is quite popular in the summer months. A great spot for the occasional climber as the climbs are straight forward and you can set some of them up by hiking around to the top if you don't feel comfortable leading them. Doug Ranck developed the area, he placed eight or fewer bolts on each of the routes.

To get to the cliff, head north out of Leadville on 91 towards Freemont Pass after about 10 minutes the cliff will be on the right and only a couple of minute walk from the obvious parking area.
