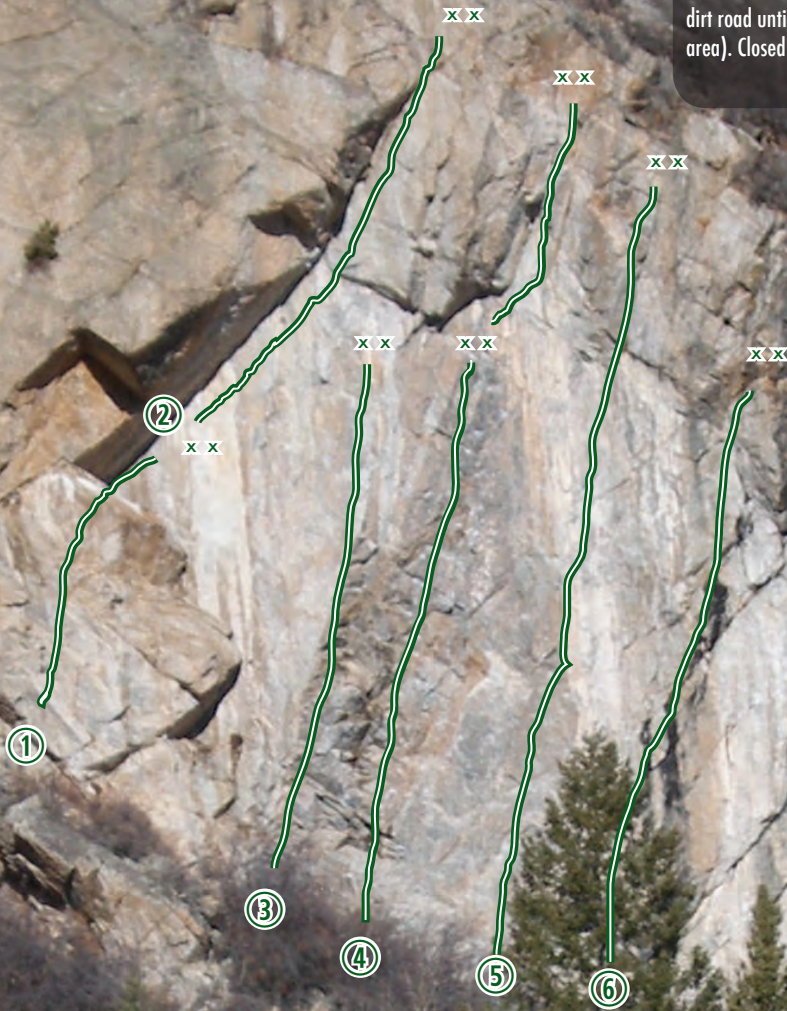

DUMP WALL SELECT

This 80' east facing crag is a popular, and warm, destination for a morning of climbing in the fall and early winter. There are other climbs in the area, these are the most popular. All climbs are bolted.

To get to the cliff, head south out of Leadville on 24 then take a right on 82 towards Twin Lakes. 2.5 miles past the town of Twin Lakes park at the Willis Gulch trailhead. Cross the road and walk up the gated dirt road until you reach the cliff (about 10 minutes from the parking area). Closed for the spring and summer nesting season.



1 Trash Man .9 40' FA Doug Ranck
Not recommended, except as a start to Shock the Monkey.

2 Shock the Monkey ★★.11c FA Ranck
Fun climbing up the pumpy overhanging corner. Start up Trash Man (not the gross corner to the right) and continue up the corner. You can back clean the intermediate anchor to reduce rope drag. If you are looking for more excitement skip the bolts and bring gear up to 2.5 inches.

3 Toxic Substance ★.12a FA D Ranck.

4 Dump Monkey ★★★.11a FA Ranck
The most popular route on the cliff. Continue up and right at the anchor at .11c. From the Shock the Monkey anchor TR the roof and difficult face directly above the Dump Monkey anchor (.12d).

5 Bear in a Dumpster ★★.12c
Good climbing. Difficult and super thin.

6 Brown Bottle Flu ★★.11d FA Ranck
Climb up and right through the brown streaks.
