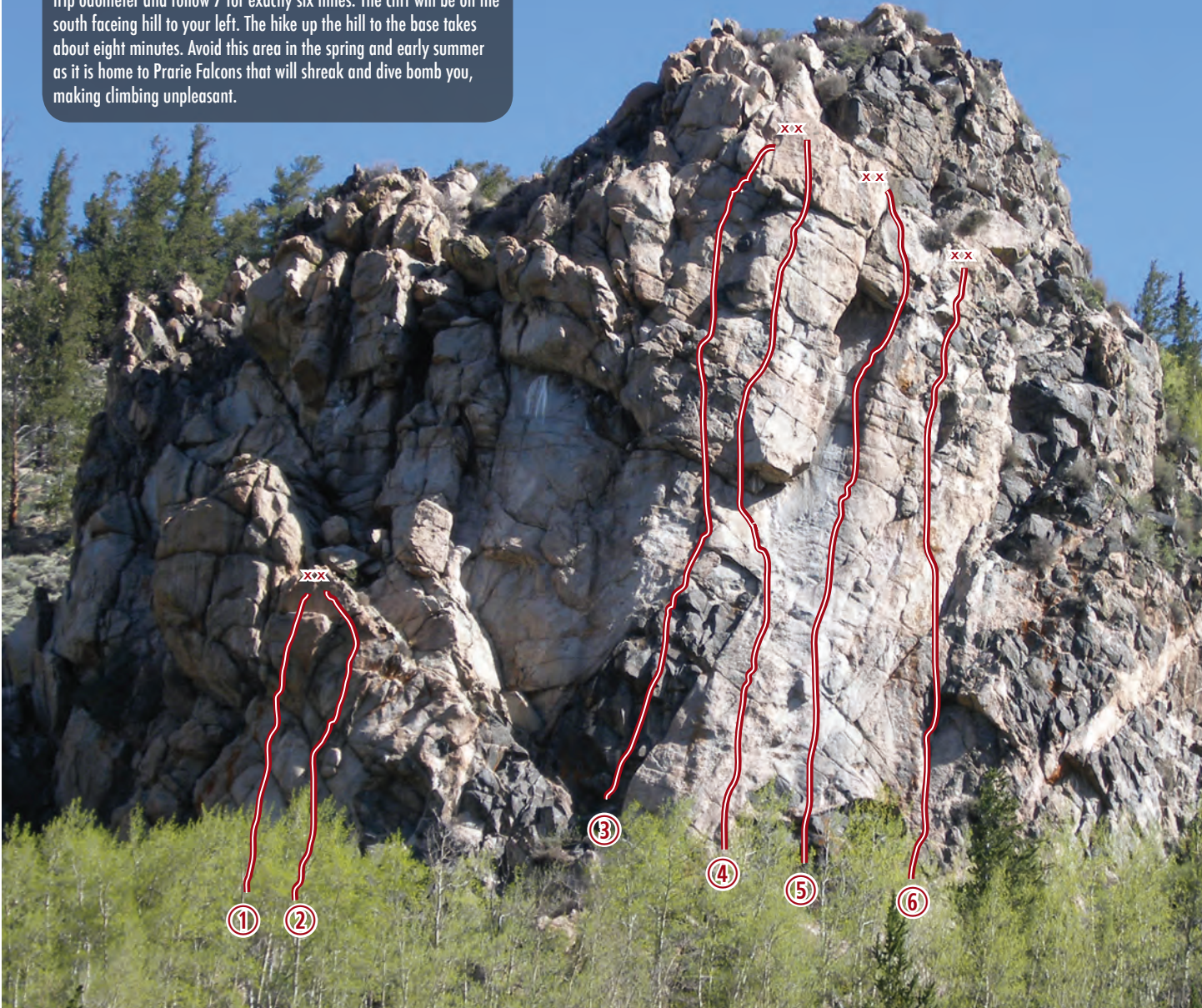


# WESTON WALL

This wall hosts a few stellar 35 meter climbs (bring a 70 meter rope). The climbing is varied and unique for cliffs close to Leadville, cool diorite intrusions distinguish this area.

To get to the cliff, head south out of Leadville on 24 then take a left just after mile marker 183 onto the Weston Pass Road (CR 7). Set your trip odometer and follow 7 for exactly six miles. The cliff will be on the south facing hill to your left. The hike up the hill to the base takes about eight minutes. Avoid this area in the spring and early summer as it is home to Prairie Falcons that will shriek and dive bomb you, making climbing unpleasant.

1 Jams and Jugs ★★.10d 60' FA Drew Spaulding  
Exposed climbing near the top. Bolts and a few small pieces.

2 Fakes and Horns ★.10a 60' FA Drew Spaulding  
Hard and interesting stemming on atypical granite structures. Bolts and one sling for a horn near the top.

3 Blocks and Locks ★★.10b 110' FA Drew Spaulding  
A wandering and fun route. Bolts and gear to three inches.

4 Chips and Salsa ★★★.11d 115' FA Drew Spaulding  
This and the next route are stellar and varied with lots of thought provoking climbing. Clip bolts and bring a light rack.

5 Seams and Smears ★★.11a 115' FA Drew Spaulding  
Great climbing. Bring a few small and medium cams to supplement the bolts.

6 Knobs and Nubbins ★★.10a 110' FA Drew Spaulding  
A couple of bolts and a rack of small and medium gear.
