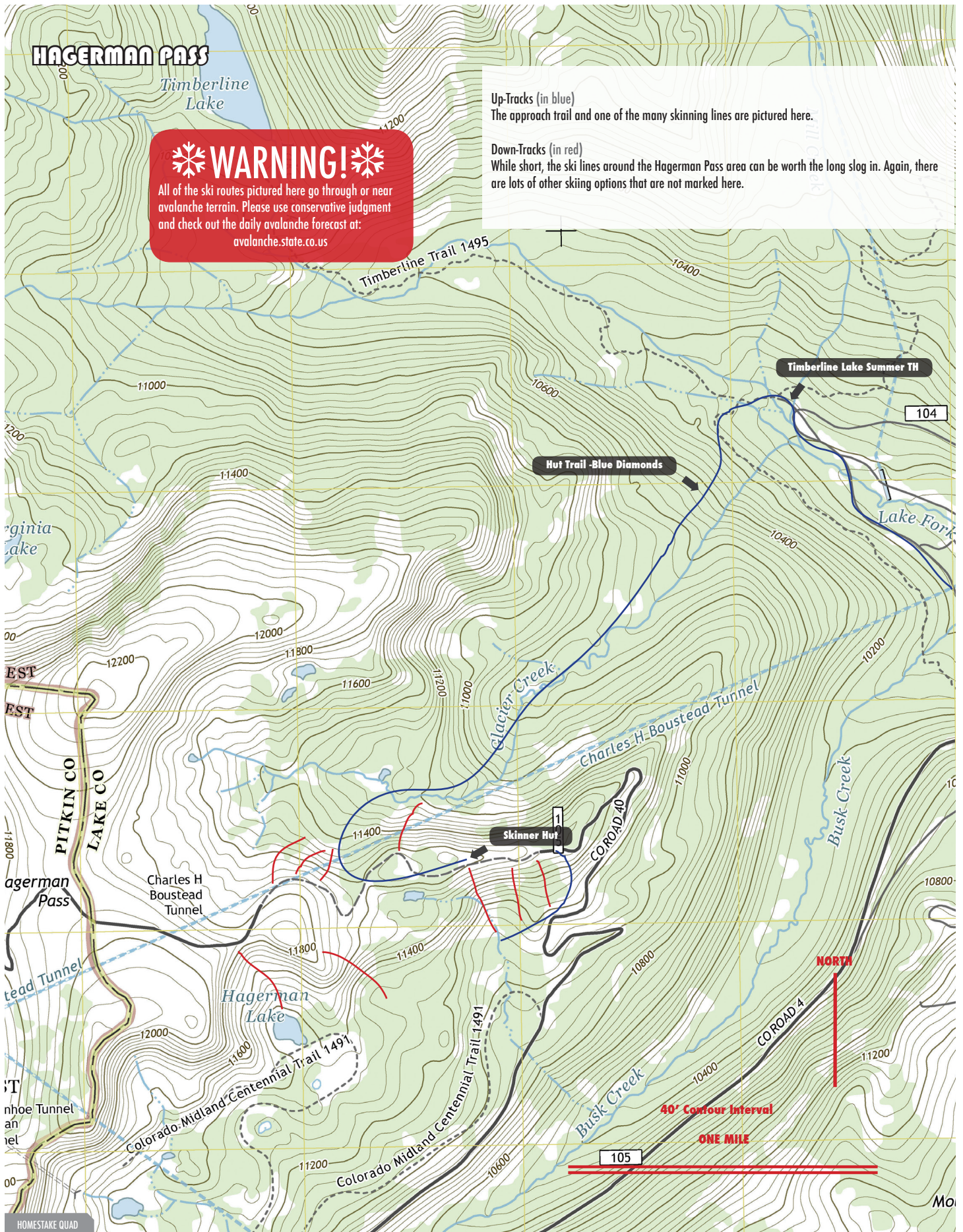

**HAGERMAN PASS**

The easiest way to ski up to the Skinner Hut and Hagerman Pass is to park at the Turquoise Lake Dam and skin around the lake on the south side to reach the Timberline Lake TH (about 7 mile of skinning on the road). From the Timberline Lake trailhead follow the blue diamond winter trail up Glacier Creek to the hut. Make sure to bring a map as it is easy to loose the trail. For a quick visit to the pass snowmobile to the Timberline Lake TH or up the snowmobile trail that goes up Busk Creek or the Hagerman Pass Road.

Hagerman Pass gets consistently more snow than the other ski zones near Leadville, bring your fat skis!
